



Parlour Tattoo Customer Checklist Covid-19

The day before your appointment

- Text/message your artist to confirm
- Hydrate
- Don't drink alcohol for 8h before your appointment

The day of your appointment

- Fill out the health risk assessment form
- If you are safe to get tattooed, confirm appointment by texting artist
- Leave all friends/family at home
- Bring health risk assessment with you and masks if you have them – you will probably need a mask for every 2h of your appointment
- Eat/drink/use the bathroom

When you have parked

- Text/message your artist – he or she will let you know when you can come in
- Leave as much stuff as you can in your vehicle including friends
- Bring purse/wallet/phone
- Bring drink or snacks if needed
- Leave gloves in garbage or your vehicle

When you enter the shop

- Artist will meet you outside and take your temperature
- You will go wash/disinfect your hands
- You will be given masks to wear for the appointment if you don't have any. Cost of \$2/mask can be paid at the end of your appointment
- You will sign liability waiver
- You will give artist health assessment form
- Personal effects will be put in bin at artists station

During your tattoo

- Masks will be changed every 2 hours (let your artist know if it starts to get damp)
- Plan breaks with artist so that physical distancing can be maintained
- If you need to eat/drink/smoke, do so outside the shop and wash/disinfect hands and put on a clean mask when you come back in the shop

After your tattoo

- Please dispose of used masks in lined garbage containers
- Follow all aftercare instructions
